Peter said the resurrection is the anchor for our hope for heaven.

1 Peter 1:3-4 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you...

Jesus said the resurrection was the ultimate proof of his ministry.

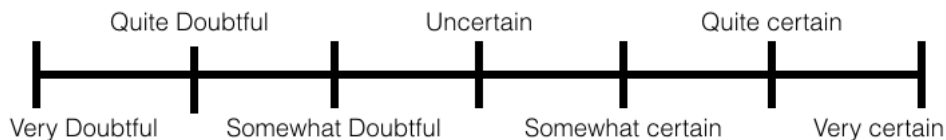
Matthew 12:38-40 Then some of the scribes and Pharisees answered him, saying, "Teacher, we wish to see a sign from you." But he answered them, "An evil and adulterous generation seeks for a sign, but no sign will be given to it except the sign of the prophet Jonah. For just as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of the great fish, so will the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.

1 Peter 3:15 ... in your hearts honor Christ the Lord as holy, always being prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you; yet do it with gentleness and respect

III. PROOFS FOR THE RESURRECTION

The "Minimal Facts" Argument

This approach “considers only those data that are so strongly attested historically that they are granted by nearly every scholar who studies the subject, even the rather skeptical ones.”

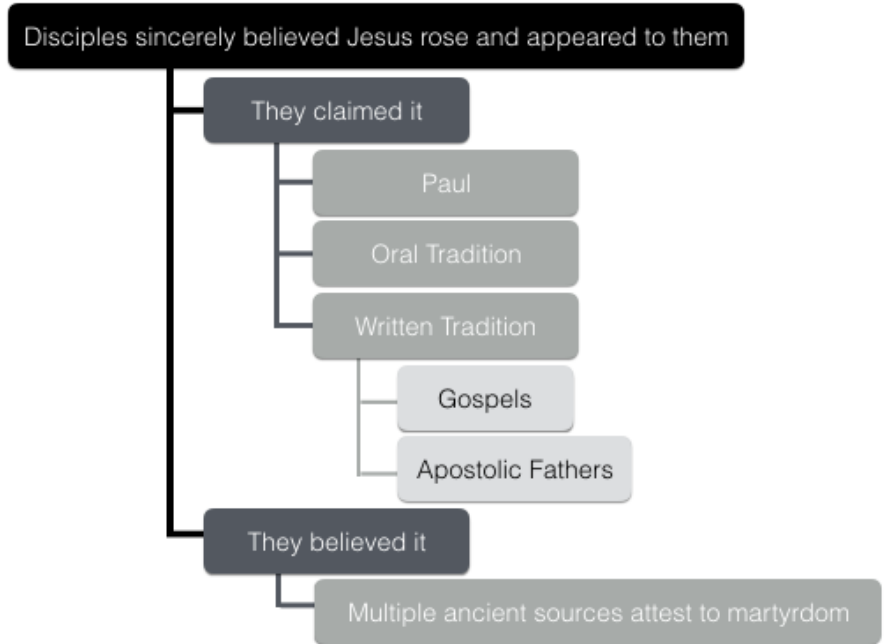
The Undisputed Facts:

1. Death by crucifixion.

2. Disciples believed he rose and appeared to them.

3. Jesus’ closest followers, skeptical observers and sworn enemies changed radically.

4. The Tomb was empty.
