Read the passage and answer the questions that follow.

Pray then like this:

Our Father in heaven,

hallowed be your name.

Your kingdom come,

on earth as it is in heaven.

Give us this day our daily bread,

and forgive us our debts,

as we also have forgiven our debtors.

And lead us not into temptation,

but deliver us from evil.

How does Jesus' prayer teach us to pray about the kingdom?

//Discuss with Your Kids

Read 2 Corinthians 2:15

For we are the aroma of Christ to God among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing.

What does Jesus smell like? ("the aroma of Christ")

How can we smell like Jesus this week?
