- Is willing to take direction as well as be self-directed; is both humble and teachable.
- Relates well to leadership, other staff, church members, and the general public.
- Understands the principles of preparing correspondence, forms, reports, etc. in a highly professional manner.

- Service prep and programming i.e. Ableton, Pro Presenter, Planning Center
- Leading or coordinating Sunday night student ministry worship.
- Leading special choir arrangements for kids singing in special services.
- Providing music and worship for staff chapel and development
- Coordinate music for weddings and funerals
- Weekly meeting with direct report
- Utilize Peace-approved software task management.
