## Trip Policies and Commitments

By registering you affirm this code of conduct.

### *Spiritual Commitment*

### *Group Policy*

Students should be in groups of three at all times (with very few exceptions). Leaving the vicinity of the houses is allowed with a leader’s permission. Everyone is expected to adhere to the schedule.

### *Cell Phone Policy*

To reduce distractions and keep our focus on spiritual formation and community, no student cell phones are permitted on this trip. All leaders will have their phone available for any communication needs.

### *Dress Code Policy*

- Our clothing ought to be modest in order to reflect our character (rather than reveal our bodies).
- Be smart with words/graphics on clothing.

#### Guys

- Swimwear: No speedos or low-rise suits. Shirts should be worn when you are not at a pool or beach.
- Clothing: Fully cover your stomach, chest, and butt.

#### Girls

- Swimwear: Fully cover your stomach, chest, and butt. Otherwise, wear a dark shirt over your swimsuit. Remember to bring a cover-up for when you are not at a pool or beach.
- Clothing: Fully cover your stomach, chest, and butt (even when you are sitting down). Leggings can be worn with a top that covers your butt.

## **Sessions and Theme**

### Session Schedule

We will have morning devotionals and nightly Bible Study sessions *every day* once we are in Alabama. Each morning devotional will include personal reflection time and every nightly Bible Study will include small group discussion time.

### Theme

This year we are studying the Gospels: Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John. At Fall Revival we studied “Covenant,” and learned all about the love and faithfulness of God towards us. We are going to capitalize on that theme and focus on Jesus, the Founder and Perfector of our faith! He brings the renewal our lives need!

### Theme Verse: Psalm 51:10-12

“Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me. Cast me not away from your presence, and take not your Holy Spirit from me. Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and uphold me with a willing spirit.”

## **Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)**

### Are phones allowed?

No student phones are permitted on this trip. Leaders will have their phones.

### What do registration costs cover?

All meals (except for meals on the road), all travel costs, a devotional booklet, a trip t-shirt, all the week’s activities, memories you won’t want to ever forget, and spiritual renewal that lasts.

### Should my student bring extra money?

Absolutely, everyone is responsible for their OWN meals while we are traveling. We are expecting to stop for food at least 6 times while traveling. Also, extra money is nice to have for souvenirs.

### How will our luggage be loaded?

Everyone will come a day early to pack their suitcase on the trailer on Friday, April 1st, between 4-5 PM. We will keep your suitcase in the trailer until we get to Alabama. You are responsible for packing your carry-on with clothes, toiletries, and meal money for until then.

Where will we be staying in Gulf Shores?

We are renting out two VRBOs that share a parking lot, pool, and beach access. Each building will include multiple bedrooms and bathrooms, a kitchen, and a large meeting space; one for girls, one for guys.

Will my student ever get to see their friends?!

Yes! Most of the trip is free time! Students can choose whoever they want to spend time with during those times. We will encourage community and will have a lot of available activities going on consistently, including time to rest, so whether you are an introvert or an extrovert, you will fit right in.

What is the dress code?

We list the dress code under Policies and Commitments. Basically, our standard is that our bodies are adequately covered. If it is questionable, don't bring it.

Will you drive straight through to Alabama?

No. That would be irresponsible. One of our priorities while traveling on this trip is to keep everyone safe. We are going to be rotating our drivers frequently, and we are stopping at hotels to ensure they get the rest they need to continue to drive safely. On Saturday April 2<sup>nd</sup> we will stop in Pelham, Alabama. On Friday April 8<sup>th</sup> we will stop in Louisville, Kentucky.

Please do not attend Spring Break if you are feeling sick. Try your best to stay healthy throughout the week leading up to it! If you cannot attend for whatever reason, a full refund will be given.
