Details

Use latest technological tools to plan, prepare and aid as you serve

- Use Planning Center Online to promptly respond to scheduling requests
- Use Planning Center to practice musical parts *before* rehearsal
- Utilize video tutorial resources to practice and learn parts *before* rehearsal
- Utilize technology like Metronome and Vocal Cues to build confidence and consistency
- Use in-ear monitoring
- Use latest technology in worship (guitar pedals, keyboard sounds, electronically triggered drums and percussion)

Humbly contribute toward selected musical arrangements

- Come on time and prepared for the service as needed
- Be familiar with music BEFORE rehearsal, coming already practiced and familiar with parts to play and sing. Transpose music into correct keys as needed. *Rehearsal* is putting all the individually *practiced* parts together.
- Lay down musical preferences to contribute to the selected arrangement as needed, be a team player to contribute toward needed instrumentation
- Be flexible through technical issues as they arise
- Be receptive to feedback from leader and team members
- Participate in team development opportunities to grow and improve

Lead and accompany congregational worship

- Play and sing with confidence! Leading the congregation in worship by example with your whole self *and also* accompanying them in singing as one body in worship

- Encourage and love-on team members between and after services, be aware of how you can love and support them as a brother or sister in Christ
 - Worship on and off the stage, leading others by example.

Qualifications:

- A committed, growing follower of Jesus Christ
 - Authentic and consistent in his/her own spiritual walk and relationships
 - Communicate well for scheduling availability
 - Ability to pay attention, prioritize, adapt to changes and function well in a live production setting
 - Demonstrates musical skill and ability to play with a band for a weekend service.
 - Knowledge of or willingness and ability to learn and develop skills
 - Ability to follow written and verbal instructions with great attention to detail
 - When on stage, be aware of and avoid anything that may be distracting during worship. (i.e. inappropriate clothing, in appropriate body language, etc.)

Time Requirements

- Time spent learning songs and practicing individually during the week as needed.
 - For a given weekend, the Worship Team member will serve from 15 minutes before rehearsal time to 15 minutes after last service
 - This position may serve as needed depending on their availability, desire, and schedule
 - Participate in regular team trainings
