8. Experience: Ideally this person would have experience in providing pastoral care in the past, specifically through visitation, conducting funerals, and ministering to senior communities.
9. Able to maintain confidentiality as needed.

### RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Serves as the primary pastor for care and calling ministries
  - Calls on people who are shut-in and/or in the hospital
  - Crisis Care
  - Seeking ways to promote the internal care of members among each other
  - Provides periodic training for interns on care and calling ministries
2. Primary officiant for Funerals
3. Helps facilitate Seniors Ministry
4. Perform other duties and tasks, such as weddings and congregational prayer, as necessary and as assigned by the Pastoral Staff
5. Facilitating programs i.e. Grief Share, to help support individuals and families.
